



KRISTINA WAHLIN Mezzo-soprano

The young talented mezzo soprano Kristina Wahlin is Swedish born and has studied singing at the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm and completed her musical education as an opera-singer at the Royal Academy of Music in London, from where she graduated in 2000.

Kristina Wahlin has sung **Cherubino** LE NOZZE DI FIGARO and the title role in Händel's **Ariodante** at Opera Funen, Denmark. Ms. Wahlin's performance of Ariodante made an exceptionally favorable impression on the critics and one newspaper announced: "A star is born". She was re-invited to sing the title role in ORFEO by Gluck in 2004.

Kristina Wahlin had great success as **Isabella** in a concert performance of L'ITALIANA IN ALGIERI at the Tivoli Concert Hall in the summer of 2004. The press wrote: "*Kristina Wahlin sang the role with all the virtuosity we admire her for. She is a miracle.*"

Ms. Wahlin has been a soloist with several symphony orchestras in Scandinavia, performing Bach, Mozart, Händel and Rossini. She recently was the mezzo soloist in Mozarts DAVIDE PENITENTE in Leipzig, Gewandhaus.

From the season 2006/07 Kristina Wahlin is a company principle at the Oper Köln and here she is performing roles such as: **Rosina, Hänsel, Isabella, Nicklausse, Cherubino and Giulio Cesare**. Besides her engagement in Köln, she frequently gives concerts and recitals with Danish and international orchestras.

Kristina Wahlin has received numerous prizes and legacies.
